

Objective:

- To understand commonly used rubrics from Kent's and Boericke's repertories in clinical practice.
- To develop the ability to select and interpret rubrics effectively.
- To apply repertorial knowledge for accurate case analysis and remedy selection.

Activity Details:

The Department of Homoeopathic Repertory and Case Taking (PG), Parul Institute of Homoeopathy and Research, organized a workshop titled "*Unlocking Clinical Wisdom: Rubrics from Kent and Boericke's Repertory*" for postgraduate scholars on 19th September 2025. The primary aim of the workshop was to provide deeper insights into the practical use of Kent's and Boericke's repertories and to train postgraduate students in rubric interpretation, selection, and clinical application.

The workshop began promptly at 10:00 AM with the **gathering and welcome address** by the anchor. This opening session created an enthusiastic environment and set the tone for an engaging academic program.

At 10:05 AM, **Dr. Disha Mitra** delivered the **brief introduction of the speaker and the event**. She highlighted the objectives of the workshop and elaborated on the continuing relevance of repertory in homoeopathic practice. Dr. Mitra also introduced the resource person, emphasizing his vast experience in repertorial training and clinical practice. Her remarks helped participants appreciate the significance of the day's academic activities.

Following this, at 10:10 AM, **Dr. Ankur Desai** addressed the audience with an insightful **speech on the occasion**. He encouraged postgraduate scholars to bridge the gap between theoretical learning and clinical application, highlighting the importance of repertory as a tool for precision in homoeopathic

prescribing. His motivating words served as an inspiration for students to participate actively in the hands-on session.

At 10:15 AM, the **felicitation of the chief resource person, Dr. Mahavrat S. Patel**, was carried out by Dr. Ankur Desai and Dr. Disha Mitra. This formal gesture of respect and acknowledgment added to the academic dignity of the event and emphasized the value of expert guidance in postgraduate training.

The most significant part of the workshop commenced at 10:20 AM with the **hands-on training session by Dr. Mahavrat S. Patel**. He conducted an interactive and practical demonstration of the use of Kent's and Boericke's repertories in real clinical cases. The session focused on converting patient narratives into repertorial language, selecting the most appropriate rubrics, differentiating between remedies using gradations, and interpreting repertorial results to arrive at the similimum.



The practical approach ensured that students could directly apply their theoretical knowledge and refine their repertorial skills. Many participants expressed that the session clarified their doubts about rubric selection and remedy differentiation, making them more confident in applying repertory to clinical practice. The interactive nature of the session ensured lively participation and enriched learning.


