Parul Institute of Ayurveda & Research is established under parent Parul University, with a vision to build a centre for excellence in education and practice of Ayurveda, to preserve, nurture and propagate the profound ancient wisdom of Indian system of medicine through quality teaching, training, medical care and research works. The Institution aims at transforming the science of Ayurveda through quality education, selfless service to the society with a truthful motto. This Institution was permitted in the year 17.11.2017 by ministry of AYUSH, GOI, New Delhi for intake of admission of 100 students. Institute is focusing on academic, cultural, social and research activities.

Potentials, skills of the student will be identified by the teacher and accordingly they will be motivated and guided for academic, co-curricular activities etc. our Institute concentrate on Social service by conducting rural health awareness programme, Swachata Abhiyan along with involvement of students in such activities. Culture has got significant role in the development of students personality, by keeping this in view, Institute motivates students to participate in various cultural programmes. To preserve the tradition, we celebrate Ganesha Chaturthi, Independence Day, Republic Day.

Khemdas Ayurved Hospital, teaching hospital of Parul Institute of Ayurved has been accredited by NABH (National Accreditation Board of Hospital) from 27th October 2018. The surveillance visit was on 12th December 2019. The teaching pharmacy is also developed nicely and able to manufacture its own products.

By arranging medical camps Khemdas Ayurved Hospital has extended the health service in 49 nearby villages and around 5,996 number of beneficiaries. Feedback of health seekers of these above camps was very good.

During the pandemic situation of COVID 19, screening camps were conducted in 12 villages and around 1,181 health seekers were benefited along with distribution of medicinal kits. Tele medicine consultation was initiated. The preparation of medicines were been done by the faculties even in the absence of manpower. Several medicines like Guduchi Ghana Vati, Dashamula Katutrayadi Ghana Vati, medicated oil for Nasya, were prepared in a bulk. New products were designed for COVID prevention like Herbal Dhoopa sticks, Herbal Tea, 3TE Immune Drops. As there were shortage of mask observed everywhere due to the sudden worsening of the pandemic situation, the non teaching staff were involved in the preparation of masks. Food packets were distributed to the needy in rura! areas. Around 1,289 masks were prepared and distributed. Created awareness about Sanjeevani App amongst the faculties and students thus promoted the importance of Ayurveda medicines in prevention of pandemic symptoms. Throughout the lockdown period the academic activities were

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conducted as per schedule. To create awareness and the current scenario regarding the COVID 19 pandemic, eleven webinars were conducted. Thus students community were benefitted. Hand wash training workshop for non teaching and hospital staff was organised.
