EXPERT LECTURE ON ACCOUNT OF CHARAK JAYANTI CELEBRATION

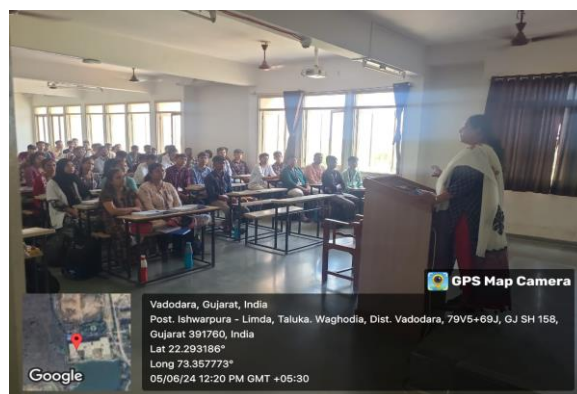

EXPERT LECTURE ON THE EXTERNAL FEATURES OF THE SPINAL CORD

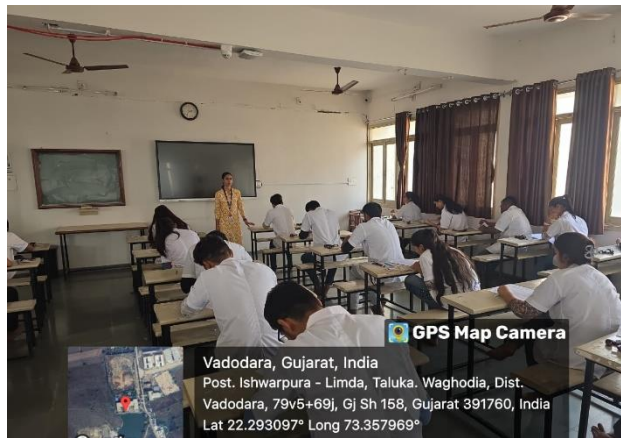
