Activity Summary

Students visited anatomy museums at **Muniyal Institute of Ayurveda Medical Sciences, Manipal** and **SDM College of Ayurveda, Udupi**. They observed skeletal remains, organs, preserved specimens, dissection hall infrastructure, and preservation methods. Faculty guided students in specimen handling, labeling, and correlation with textbook knowledge.
