1. PREAMBLE

Parul University recognizes the pivotal role of sports in enhancing physical health, mental well-being, and overall personal growth. We believe that sports contribute immensely to enriching the university experience by fostering a sense of community, teamwork, and camaraderie among students, faculty, and staff.

Our Sports Policy is dedicated to promoting excellence in sports at both inter-university and intramural levels by providing ample opportunities for training, coaching, and competition. We value the ability of sports to instill leadership skills, discipline, and a sense of accomplishment and are committed to supporting student-athletes in their pursuit of excellence.

This policy is grounded in the principles of inclusivity, fairness, and respect for diversity. We strive to provide a safe and supportive environment for all members of our university community to participate in sports, regardless of their backgrounds or identities.

Furthermore, we emphasize the importance of sports in upholding the values of fair play, sportsmanship, and ethical conduct. We expect all students to embody these values, both on and off the field, and to engage in sports with integrity, respect, and professionalism.

2. VISION

Parul University's vision for sports is to foster the holistic development of its students through active participation in sports, creating a thriving culture of excellence within the university.

3. MISSION

The mission of the university's Sports Policy is to establish a structured framework that promotes and supports sports activities and programs, contributing to the physical health, mental well-being, and personal development of students, faculty, and staff. The key objectives are:

- To promote and support a diverse range of sports activities that meet the interests and needs of the university's students, including both competitive and recreational sports programs.
- To provide sufficient facilities, equipment, and resources for sports programs, ensuring they are safe, accessible, and well-maintained.
- To encourage and support student-athletes in their quest for excellence, offering them opportunities for high-level training, coaching, and competition.
- To foster an inclusive and diverse sports culture, ensuring that all members of the university community, regardless of their backgrounds or identities, have equal opportunities to engage in sports activities.
- To collaborate with other universities, sports organizations, and community partners to promote sports, share best practices, and optimize resources for the development and management of sports activities.

- To promote a culture of health and wellness through sports and physical activity, supporting the development of well-rounded individuals who are equipped to face the challenges of an ever-changing world.

4. ADMISSION POLICY FOR SPORTS SCHOLARSHIPS AND FELLOWSHIPS SCHEME

- 1- Numerous types of Scholarships have been introduced by the Parul University for inspiring meritorious students. The quantity of scholarship/fellowship and period of scholarship/fellowship is subject to change from time to time. Different full and partial sports scholarships, fellowship, stipends and fee relaxations offered by Parul University to deserving applicant (players/athletes) for admission year 2024-25 and onwards shall be as follows.

- 4.1 Students shortlisted for participation in Khelo India University camps, games, and events organized by AIU will receive free boarding and lodging during training camps held prior to such events/competitions. Additionally, students admitted under the sports quota will be provided free boarding and lodging in university hostels during examinations (mid-term and ESE/EYE) conducted by the university.
- 4.2 Students admitted under the sports quota must submit a certificate from an appropriate sports federation, demonstrating their achievement in the sport they wish to continue pursuing at the university. Recognized international/national sports bodies include:
- *International/National recognized sports Bodies.**
- a) Olympic Games by IOC
 - b) World Championships under International Sports Federations (IOA and/or MYAS recognized/One HoI - Member affiliated Games).
 - c) Asian Games by Olympic Council of Asia.
 - d) Asian Championship organized by International Federation of concerned game (recognized/affiliated by MYAS and/or IOA).
 - e) Commonwealth Games, S.A.F. Games and Afro Asian Games.
 - f) Paralympics Games (recognized/affiliated by IOC and/or MYAS).
 - g) National Games (recognized/affiliated by IOC and/or MYAS).
 - h) All India University
 - i) School Game Federation of India
- 4.3 Scholarship benefits will be withdrawn or cancelled if a student is found in violation of the university's code of conduct, sports federation rules, or is involved in acts of indiscipline or misbehaviour.
- 4.4 Students availing of accommodation under the Sports Facility for AIU/Khelo India University game coaching camps must maintain 90% attendance in training/coaching sessions organized by the Department of Physical Education & Sports. Failure to do so will result in the withdrawal or cancellation of their scholarship.
- 4.5 Scholarships will only be offered for games or sports recognized by the Indian Olympic Committee (IOC), Indian Olympic Association (IOA), Association of Indian Universities (AIU), Khelo India University Games, SGFI (School Games Federation of India), and MYAS (Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports).
- 4.6 Scholarships are limited to UG and PG courses under the Faculty of Arts, Commerce, Management, Applied Science, Social Work, Law, Library Science, and Computer Applications. These scholarships do not apply to courses under the Faculty of Medicine, AYUSH, Pharmacy, Nursing, and Physiotherapy. However, students placed in A+, A, or B+ grade categories based on their sports performance may be eligible for scholarships with approval from the President or Vice President, even if they apply to courses in Faculties such as Engineering, Architecture, Hotel Management, Fine Arts, and Design.
- 4.7 Students covered under the Sports Policy must obtain prior permission from the Director of the Department of Physical Education & Sports before participating in any sports events or games.

- 4.8 Hostel room allocation for students covered under the Sports Policy will be based on merit and the availability of vacancies in the respective hostels.
- 4.9 The mere submission of an application for scholarships under the Sports Policy does not guarantee the benefits. The university reserves the right to determine the number of scholarships and the sports eligible for the scholarship.
- 4.10 Candidates applying for scholarships under the Sports Quota must meet the eligibility criteria set by the Association of Indian Universities (AIU) for national games covered under the quota.
- 4.11 For admission to select UG courses under the Sports Policy, a gap of up to two years after Std. XII is allowed. There is no such restriction for students applying for select PG courses.
- 4.12 Candidates with Merit Certificates from Khel Mahakumbh will be considered for B-Grade scholarship benefits.
- 4.13 Only achievements and merit certificates from the preceding two years will be considered for scholarships under the Sports Policy.
- 4.14 Students receiving scholarships under the Sports Policy must participate in training, coaching sessions, camps, and tournaments as required by the university. They are not allowed to represent any other institution, association, or club without prior university permission. Failure to comply will result in the cancellation of scholarship benefits.
- 4.15 Scholarship benefits will be applicable for the standard minimum duration of any course. However, if a student misses an examination due to participation in sports events, leading to an extension of their term, they may still be eligible for continued scholarship benefits. In all other cases, students will not be entitled to receive scholarships beyond the minimum duration of the course.
- 4.16 The Department of Physical Education and Sports will be responsible for reviewing applications for admission under the Sports Policy, determining the appropriate scholarship for eligible candidates, verifying the credentials provided by applicants, and recommending eligible candidates to the University for Admission under the Sports Policy. Admission will be confirmed upon final approval from the President and Vice President.
- 4.17 Registration & Selection Process**
- I. Students can apply by submitting relevant documents at <https://admissions.paruluniversity.ac.in>.
 - II. Candidates must present original documents/certificates during the document verification process.
 - III. Candidates are required to be present for performance trials whenever scheduled by the university.
 - IV. After a thorough review of applications and satisfactory performance in the trials, eligible candidates must complete the university's admission procedures.
 - V. To renew the scholarship for the following term/year, candidates must demonstrate outstanding performance in the sport(s) for which they were awarded the scholarship.
 - VI. The university reserves the right to determine the specifics of scholarships awarded under the Sports Policy.

4.18 Discontinuation of Scholarship/Fellowship and Incentives

- I. Non-fulfillment of the eligibility criteria prescribed by AIU or Khelo India University Games.
- II. Violation of the code of conduct set by the university or the relevant sports federation.
- III. Disciplinary action taken against the student for acts of indiscipline or use of unfair means during examinations.
- IV. Failure to participate in Zone/All India Inter University competitions without a valid reason.
- V. Failure to maintain a minimum of 90% attendance in training camps organized within or outside the university campus.
- VI. If a player tests positive for doping during any competition or trials, their admission to the university will be cancelled.

5. CRITERIA FOR CASH INCENTIVES (IN INR) TO SPORTSPERSONS

The following cash incentives will be awarded to candidates admitted under the Sports Policy who have won Gold, Silver, or Bronze Medals in the competitions listed below during their tenure at the university. In addition to cash prizes, the university will present them with a blazer and memento.

5.1 Special Incentives for Unlisted Competitions: Candidates who have participated in any unlisted games, tournaments, or competitions and brought distinction to the university may be awarded cash incentives at the university's discretion, based on recommendations from the Equivalence Committee.

5.2 Team Event Incentives: For team achievements, the incentive will be calculated based on team size. If the incentive for an individual event is represented as 'A', the incentive for a team event will be computed as follows:

- a) For a team of 2 persons: $1.5 \times 'A' / \text{number of persons in the team}$
- b) For a team of 3 or 4 persons: $2 \times 'A' / \text{number of persons in the team}$
- c) For a team of 5 to 10 persons: $3 \times 'A' / \text{number of persons in the team}$
- d) For a team of 11 to 15 persons: $5 \times 'A' / \text{number of persons in the team}$
- e) For a team of 16 persons or more: $7 \times 'A' / \text{number of persons in the team}$.

6. FACILITIES PROVIDED BY THE UNIVERSITY TO STUDENTS ADMITTED UNDER THE SPORTS POLICY FOR ATTENDING SPORTS TRAINING/COACHING CAMPS FOR AIU/KHELO INDIA UNIVERSITY GAMES

- 6.1 A special diet or a diet allowance of ₹200 per day will be provided to candidates participating in the coaching camp.
- 6.2 External experts/coaches shall be paid a remuneration of up to ₹1,000 per day.
- 6.3 Internal experts/coaches (university employees) shall receive a remuneration of up to ₹200 per session.
- 6.4 Travelling allowance for candidates will be limited to sleeper class railway/state transport fares and will be reimbursed upon submission of relevant proofs.
- 6.5 Expenses incurred by candidates for travel to and from camp venues outside Vadodara will be reimbursed based on submission of receipts for rail/bus tickets or rickshaw fares.
- 6.6 For outstation candidates residing in university hostels, the university will provide transport to and from the camp venue (within Vadodara but outside the university campus). This transport facility will not be available for candidates residing in Vadodara City.
- 6.7 Coaching camps will be held for a duration of up to four weeks before a competition/tournament.
- 6.8 If external facilities, such as playgrounds or sports equipment, need to be hired for coaching camps, the Department of Physical Education and Sports must seek prior approval from the President/Vice President.

7. GUIDELINES FOR PARTICIPATION IN AIU/KHELO INDIA UNIVERSITY GAMES

The AIU/Khelo India University Games are organized annually by the Association of Indian Universities (AIU). Students of Parul University may participate in these games if their respective teams or individual players are deemed fit to compete at the required level. The Selection Committee, constituted specifically for this purpose, will finalize the teams and players for participation.

7.1 Coach and Manager

Each participating team will be accompanied by one coach and one manager during the AIU/Khelo India University Games. The Director of Physical Education & Sports will appoint both the coach and manager for this purpose.

7.2 T.A. and D.A. for Players

Travel Allowance (T.A.):

For participation in West/South West Zone AIU competitions, sleeper class railway fare or bus fare (including reservation charges) from the university to the competition venue and back will be provided.

For participation in Khelo India University Games, A.C. III-tier railway fare (including reservation charges) will be provided from the university to the competition venue and back.

Daily Allowance (D.A.):

Players representing the university in AIU/Khelo India University Games will receive a daily allowance of ₹500.

7.3 T.A. and D.A. for Coach and Manager of Parul University**Travel Allowance (T.A.):**

Eligibility for mode of travel (by rail and road) will be determined in line with university policies for the Coach and Manager accompanying the team.

For travel to the competition venue, the appropriate fare, along with reservation charges, will be reimbursed.

7.5 Match Refreshment

Players representing Parul University in AIU, Khelo India, and Senior National competitions will receive match refreshments at the rate of ₹50 per match.

7.6 Fees Covered by the University for AIU

The following fees will be covered by the university for AIU participation:

- a) AIU Registration Fee: ₹3000
- b) Match Fee: As per AIU Guidelines
- c) Ball Fee: As per AIU Guidelines
- d) Shuttlecock Fee: As per AIU Guidelines
- e) Ammunition Fee: As per AIU Guidelines

7.7 Sports Kit Allowance

Players representing the university in AIU/Khelo India University Games will receive a sports kit worth up to ₹4,000, which may include one track suit, one pair of shoes, one kit bag, etc., as determined by the Department of Physical Education and Sports based on the requirements for different sports/games.

7.8 Local Conveyance and Bedding Charges

Parul University will cover local transportation and lodging expenses for team members while competing in the AIU/Khelo India University Games, in accordance with the policies of the organizing university.

7.9 Medical Charges

Players, managers, and coaches in need of medical treatment will receive necessary medical assistance and medication during coaching camps, training sessions, or tournaments upon submission of certified vouchers.

7.10 Documents Required for Participation in AIU/Khelo India University Games

Students selected to represent Parul University must submit photocopies of the following documents:

- a) Parul University ID card
- b) Mark sheets from matriculation, higher secondary, graduation, diploma, and post-graduation (as applicable)
- c) Three passport-size photographs
- d) An undertaking regarding good conduct during the tournament
- e) A medical fitness certificate issued by a competent medical practitioner at Parul Sevashram Hospital or any government hospital

7.11 Submission of Accounts

The coach or manager must submit vouchers and bills for expenses within 10 days of returning from any sports competition to the Director of Physical Education and Sports, following the stipulated procedure for settlement of accounts.

7.12 Selection Criteria

- 7.12.1. Players will be selected based on their performance during the trials.
- 7.12.2. If an outstanding player is unable to attend the final selection trials due to participation in national sports activities, they may be included in the selected team with the approval of the Director of Physical Education & Sports.
- 7.12.3. The selection committee will consist of the following members:
 - i. Director of Physical Education and Sports
 - ii. Deputy Director of Physical Education and Sports
 - iii. Two Assistant Directors of Physical Education and Sports
 - iv. One concerned coach
 - v. Up to two external experts, if required (based on the approval of the Director of Physical Education and Sports)

8. Open/Invitational Tournaments

- 8.1** Students of Parul University may participate in Open/Invitational tournaments at the state, national, and international levels, provided they receive prior game approval from the Director of Physical Education and Sports. Participation will be permitted solely based on the recognition of relevant federations and national bodies.
- 8.2** The university will cover all expenses incurred by players participating in these tournaments. If a coach or manager wishes to accompany the players, they must obtain prior permission from the Director of Physical Education and Sports.

9. Intramural Competitions

- 9.1** An Intramural Committee will be established to organize inter-college and inter-hostel sports competitions. The calendar for these competitions will be prepared in accordance with the AIU/Khelo India University Games sports calendar.
- 9.2** Officials for the inter-college and inter-hostel competitions may be invited from the Sports Authority of Gujarat (SAG), Sports Authority of India (SAI), state associations, or federations.

9.3 Position holders will be awarded merit certificates, medals, and trophies for their achievements.

9.4 A travel allowance (TA) and daily allowance (DA) ranging from ₹1,000 to ₹1,500 per head will be provided to all external officials, along with complimentary meals, subject to prior permission from the Director of Physical Education and Sports.
