NOTIFICATION

Sub: Transfer of / mention of credits earned during D.Pharm in transcript issued upon completion of B.Pharm programme and revision in the format of final marksheet issued to B.Pharm graduates

Ref: (i) Proceedings of the Eighteenth Meeting of the Governing Body held on December 2, 2024

(ii) Orders of the Provost

PREAMBLE:

In compliance with the regulations of the Pharmacy Council of India (PCI), New Delhi, the Dean, Faculty of Pharmacy, proposed the following during the Eighteenth Meeting of the Governing Body held on December 2, 2024:

- a) Candidates admitted to the B.Pharm program after completing the D.Pharm program will have 52 credit points transferred from their D.Pharm studies.
- b) The final mark sheet issued upon successful completion of the B.Pharm program will include these 52 transferred credit points, in addition to the 161 credit points earned during the B.Pharm program from the 3rd to the 8th semester and c) revision in the format of final marksheet issued to B.Pharm graduates. The proposal was approved by the Governing Body. Hence, the Order.

ORDER:

Candidates who enroll in the B.Pharm program after completing the D.Pharm program shall have their final mark sheet or transcript of B.Pharm reflect 52 credit points earned during their D.Pharm studies. These 52 credits will be displayed alongside the 161 credit points accrued during their B.Pharm program from the 3rd to the 8th semester and will be included in the final mark sheet issued upon the successful completion of the B.Pharm program.

Further, the final marksheet for B.Pharm graduates stand revised as follows:

Credit Points Instead of Credits: The term "credits" should be replaced with "credit points" throughout the marksheet.

Total Credit Points: The marksheet should explicitly state the total credit points earned instead of merely listing them.

Credit Point Multiplied by Grade Point: The marksheet should display the product of credit points and grade points for each course.
