The following 12-digit nomenclature shall be adopted for the course codes of various categories within the FYUP framework, including Discipline Specific Courses, Ability Enhancement Courses, Value Added Courses, Skill Enhancement Courses, Minor Courses, University Electives, Internships/OJT, Research Projects, and Exit Courses:

Course Code Assignment Guidelines:

1. Courses from the University Elective Pool: If a course is selected by a faculty from the University Elective subjects' pool, the course code will be pre-assigned as per university guidelines.

Example: UE - II offered by FIT&CS: Internet Technology & Web designing - 05010102UE01

2. Courses from Online MOOC with Existing Faculty Association: If a faculty selects a course from an Online MOOC that aligns with an existing university department, the code will include

the offering faculty's unique code as the first two digits, with "M1" as the third and fourth digits, followed by the standard format.

Example:

- UE - II opted by FIT&CS: Discrete Mathematics (NPTEL – Category: Mathematics) - 11M10602UE01 (Department of Applied Sciences)
- UE - II opted by FHMCT: Overview and Perspectives of Values (SWAYAM - Category: Humanities and Social Science) - 15M10102UE01 (Faculty of Liberal Arts)

3. Courses from Online MOOC without Existing Faculty Association: For MOOC courses not associated with any existing faculty, the faculty code "00" will be used, with "M1" as the third and fourth digits, followed by the standard format.

Example:

1. UE - II opted by FHMCT: Indian Culture: Perspective for Tourism (SWAYAM - Category: Multidisciplinary) - 00M10102UE01 (using Faculty code "00")

Note: For all cases, the fourth digit will be "1" for the Undergraduate Program and "2" for the Postgraduate Program.
