Sub: Introducing Internship in 3-Year B.Sc in Paramedical and Health Sciences Program at PIPHS

PREAMBLE:

Principal, PIPHS proposed introducing internship in 3-Year B.Sc in Paramedical and Health Sciences Program at PIPHS to address the challenges faced by students pursuing 3-year B.Sc in Paramedical and Health Sciences when seeking equivalence for further studies abroad and to provide them with practical knowledge and experience during the Eighteenth Meeting of the Governing Body held on December 2, 2024 which was approved by the Governing Body. Hence, the Order.

ORDER:

- 1.To address the challenges faced by students pursuing 3-year B.Sc in Paramedical and Health Sciences when seeking equivalence for further studies abroad and to provide them with practical knowledge and experience, provision of undertaking a one year internship is made for students enrolled in the 3-year B.Sc in Paramedical and Health Sciences program at PIPHS upon completion of their three years of study.
- 2.The internship will be conducted in hospitals comprising a minimum of 500 beds to ensure exposure to diverse medical scenarios and practical learning opportunities
- 3.Students must apply for a No Objection Certificate (NOC) from PIPHS prior to commencing their internship.
- 4.Students undertaking the internship must maintain a minimum attendance of 75% throughout the duration of the internship.
- 5.PIPHS will formulate comprehensive guidelines at a later stage for practical training, professional conduct, and engagement with clinical settings during the internship period to ensure that students receive structured and standardized training experiences.
