Based on the actual date of commencement of classes, the concerned HOI shall prepare the calendar for first semester ensuring 90 days of teaching.
- For other first year degree programmes and lateral entry programmes (direct admission in 2nd year in different disciplines), based on the actual date of commencement of classes, the concerned HOI shall prepare the calendar for first semester/ third semester (lateral entry) ensuring 90 days of teaching. Further, the schedule for examinations for other first year degree programmes and lateral entry programmes shall be prepared by the concerned HOIs in consultation with the Controller of Examination and shall be notified separately.
