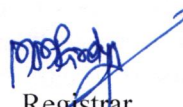

- For the first year degree programmes of those courses for which ACPC / ACPDC / ACPUGMEC allots the seats, the first semester will commence based on the directions of the ACPC / ACPDC / ACPUGMEC. Based on the actual date of commencement of classes, the concerned HOI shall prepare the calendar for first semester ensuring 90 days of teaching.
- For other first year degree programmes and lateral entry programmes (direct admission in 2nd year in different disciplines), based on the actual date of commencement of classes, the concerned HOI shall prepare the calendar for first semester/ third semester (lateral entry) ensuring 90 days of teaching. Further, the schedule for examinations for other first year degree programmes and lateral entry

B) Weekly Operating Days for AYUSH, Physiotherapy, Nursing, PIPH, and PIMSR:

- 1. All colleges will now operate **six days a week**, from **Monday to Saturday (except on public holidays declared by the University)**.
- 2. Morning Shift institutes will operate as per their current standard shift schedule, and General Shift institutes will operate as per their current standard shift schedule.
- 3. The existing schedule followed on Saturday(s) shall remain unchanged.
- 4. Reporting timings for Staff and Students followed currently shall continue.

College Operating Days and Schedule Implementations

The updated operational schedule for all colleges for the upcoming Academic year is as mentioned below:

A) Weekly Operating Days for All Colleges (Except AYUSH, Physiotherapy, Nursing, PIPH, and PIMSR):

1. All colleges will now operate **six days a week**, from **Monday to Saturday (except on public holidays declared by the University)**.
2. **3rd Saturday** of each month will be a holiday for staff. **1st and 3rd Saturdays** of every month will be holidays for students.
3. All Saturdays other than the 1st and 3rd Saturdays (where applicable) shall be treated as regular working days for both staff and students.
4. Morning Shift institutes will operate as per their standard shift schedule, and General Shift institutes will operate as per their standard shift schedule.
5. For the **1st Saturday** of every month, the university shall operate in General Shift for all staff members, with working hours from 09:00 AM to 05:00 PM.

programmes shall be prepared by the concerned HOIs in consultation with the Controller of Examination and shall be notified separately.

- The ESE of common subjects offered under different subject components as per NEP 2020 in different Faculties (applicable to those Faculties where in NEP 2020 has been implemented) will be conducted in the first week of the commencement of examinations. The COE shall notify the schedule of the ESE of the said common subjects to be conducted in the 1st week of commencement of examinations separately in advance.
- End Semester Examinations (Practical) shall be conducted between 07:30 AM to 05:00 PM.
- The period between the last date for submission of Continuous/Internal Evaluation marks and the End of the Semester shall be utilized strictly for academic engagement such as revision classes, doubt-solving sessions, mentoring, academic counselling, and other relevant non-evaluative activities; no examinations or submissions of any assignments shall be scheduled during this period.
- In programmes where there are no practical examinations and only theory examinations, the theory examinations may commence during the period scheduled for End Semester Practical Examinations.
- Next Academic term will be start on **07.06.2027**.
