College Operating Days and Schedule Implementations

The updated operational schedule for all colleges for the upcoming Academic year is as mentioned below:

A) Weekly Operating Days for All Colleges (Except AYUSH, Physiotherapy, Nursing, PIPH, and PIMSR):

1. All colleges will now operate **six days a week**, from **Monday to Saturday (except on public holidays declared by the University)**.
2. **3rd Saturday** of each month will be a holiday for staff. **1st and 3rd Saturdays** of every month will be holidays for students.
3. All Saturdays other than the 1st and 3rd Saturdays (where applicable) shall be treated as regular working days for both staff and students.
4. Morning Shift institutes will operate as per their standard shift schedule, and General Shift institutes will operate as per their standard shift schedule.
5. For the **1st Saturday** of every month, the university shall operate in General Shift for all staff members, with working hours from 09:00 AM to 05:00 PM.
